During my time at the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission amid the global pandemic, we distributed over \$5 billion in unemployment benefits to support Oklahomans in one of the most critical times of need in recent history. When I took the position to lead OESC I knew I'd never get another chance to help that many people, and it's been the absolute honor of a lifetime to have stood with so many Oklahomans in a time of such great need.

My time at OTRD leading an extraordinary team of over 750 individuals has been an amazing bookend to my state career. I will always look back on my time in service with a deep appreciation and admiration for the dedicated employees I have had the privilege to work alongside over my time with the State of Oklahoma. To wake up each day and roll up your sleeves for something you believe in is a beautiful thing. It's been a great honor to serve the citizens of Oklahoma.
